

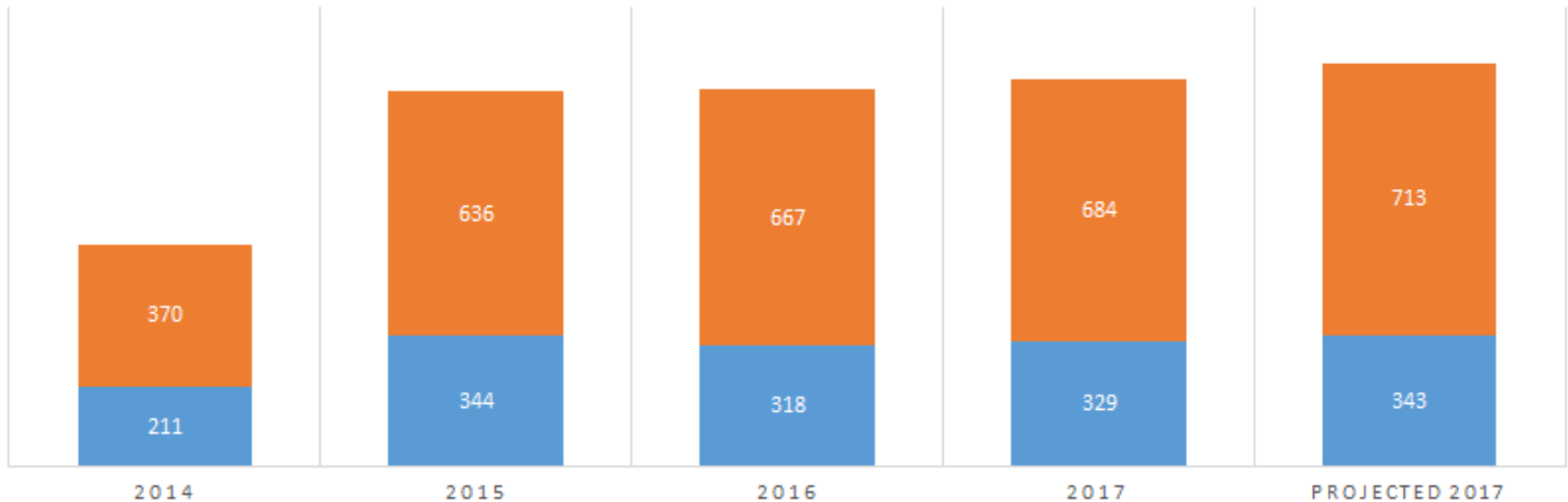
CITISTATSMART – MAKING BALTIMORE SAFE

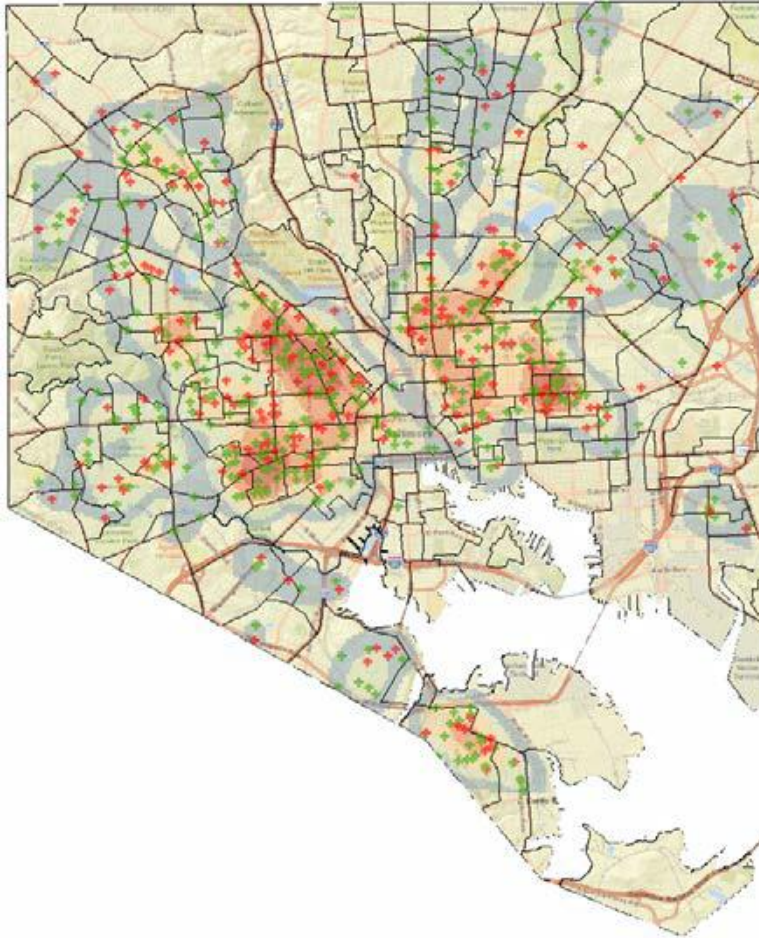
MURDER AND NON-FATAL SHOOTINGS BY YEAR

■ Murder ■ Non-fatal Shootings

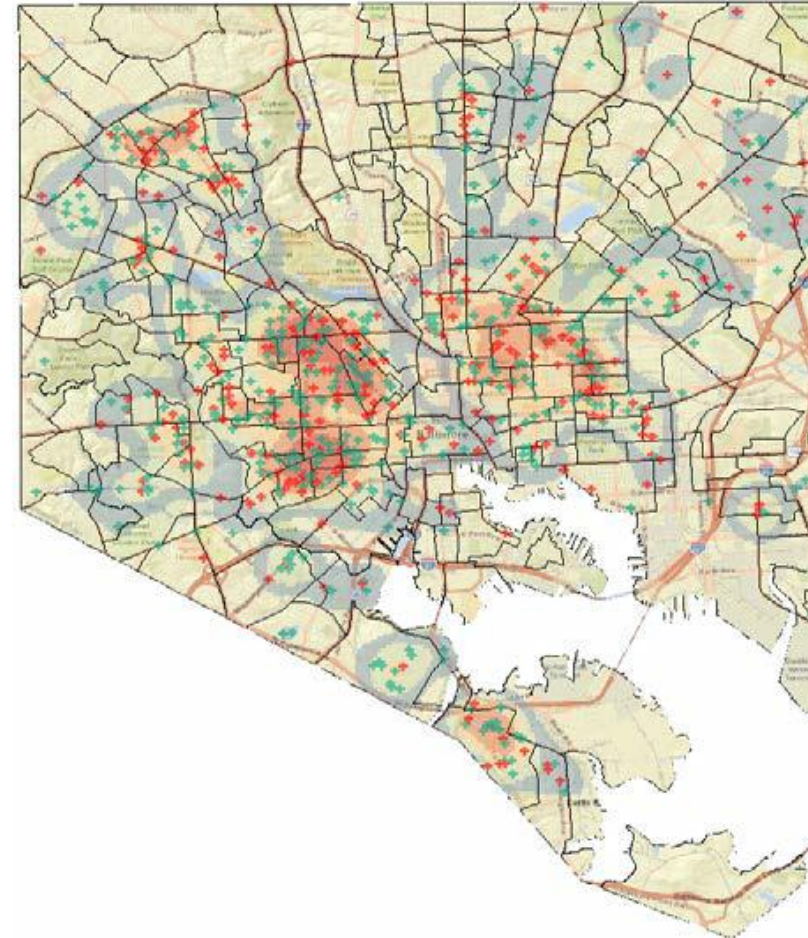


GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF HOMICIDES AND NFS'S

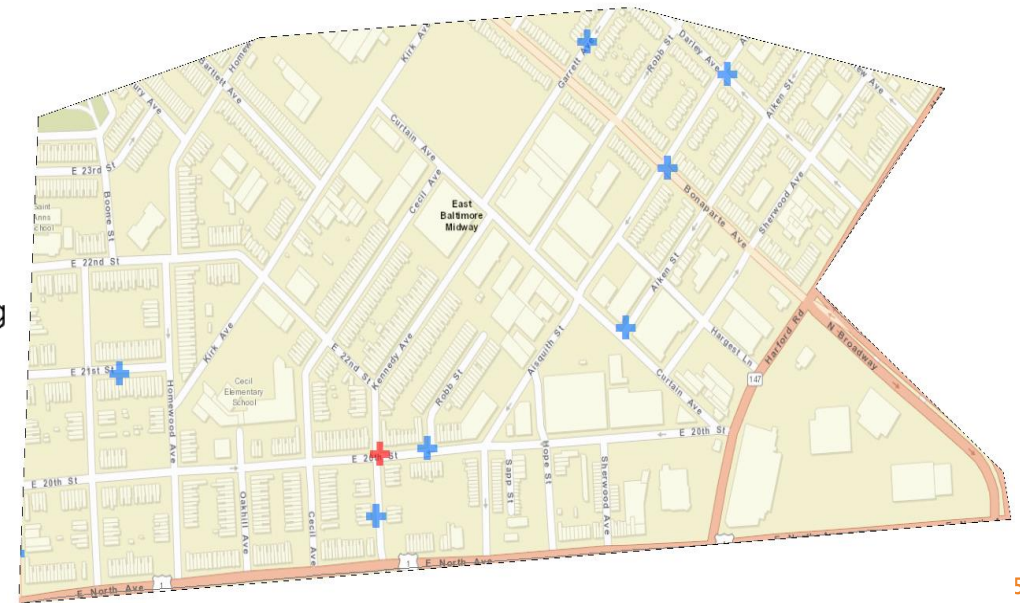

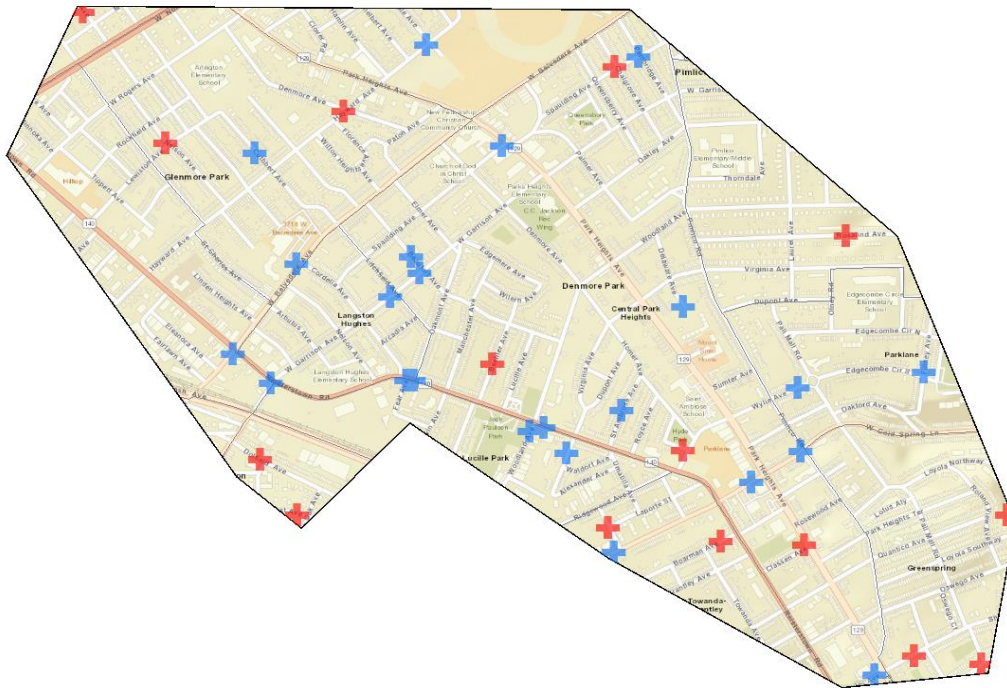

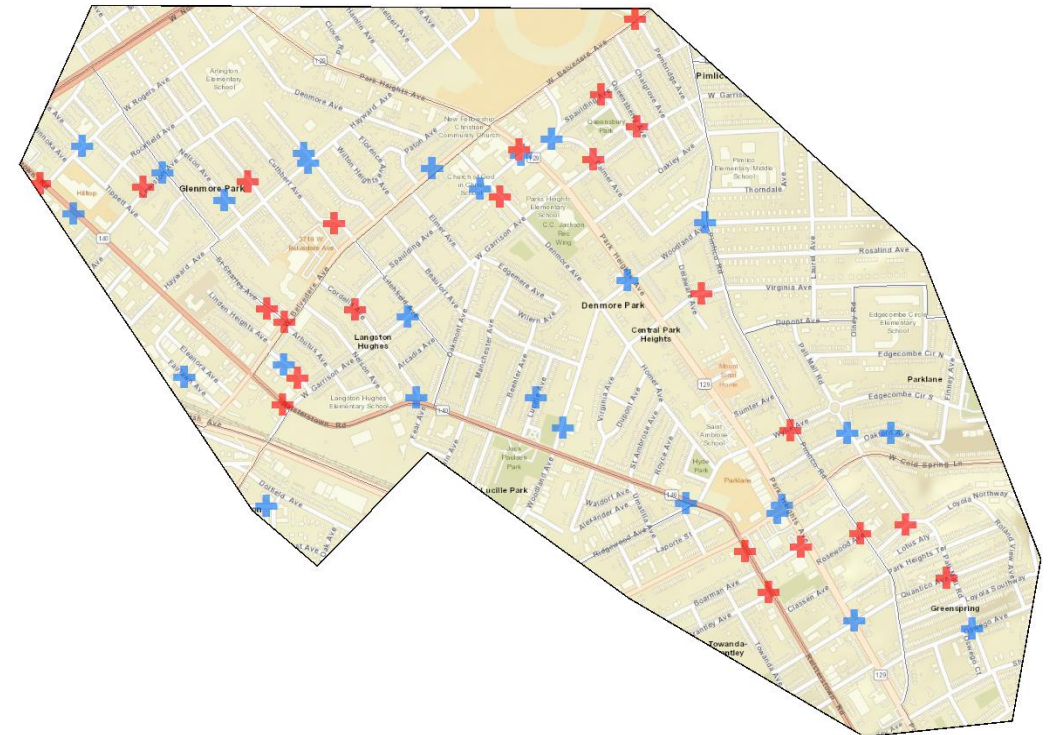

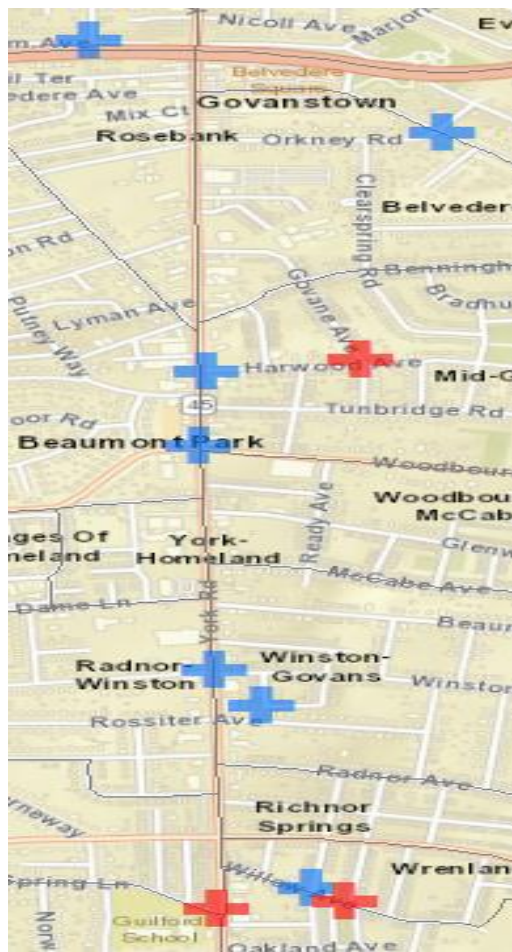

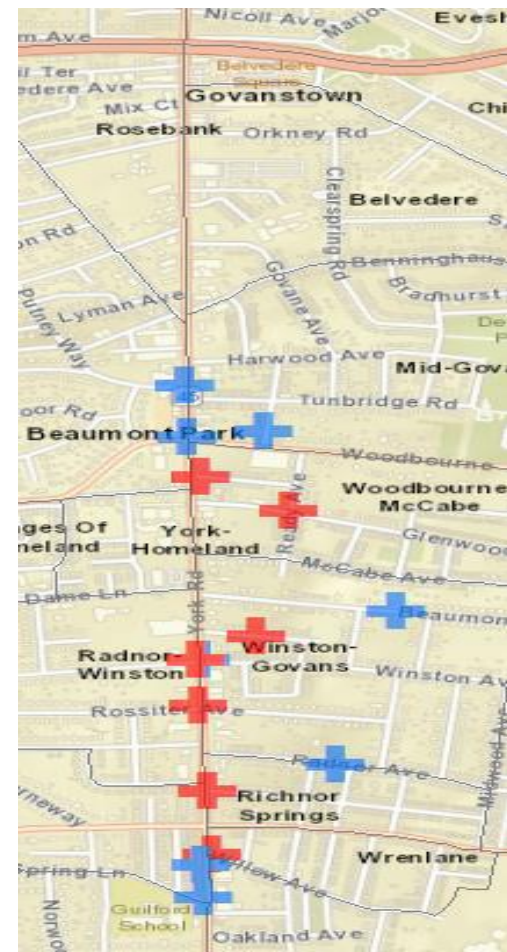

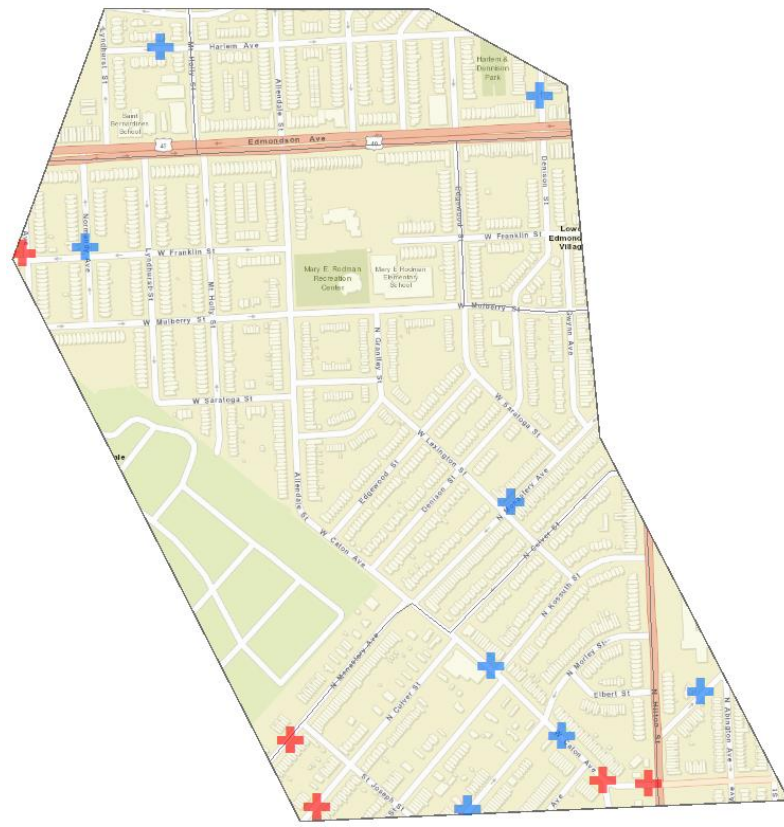

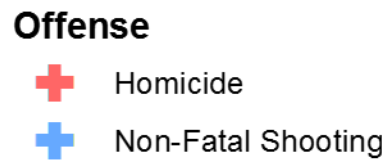

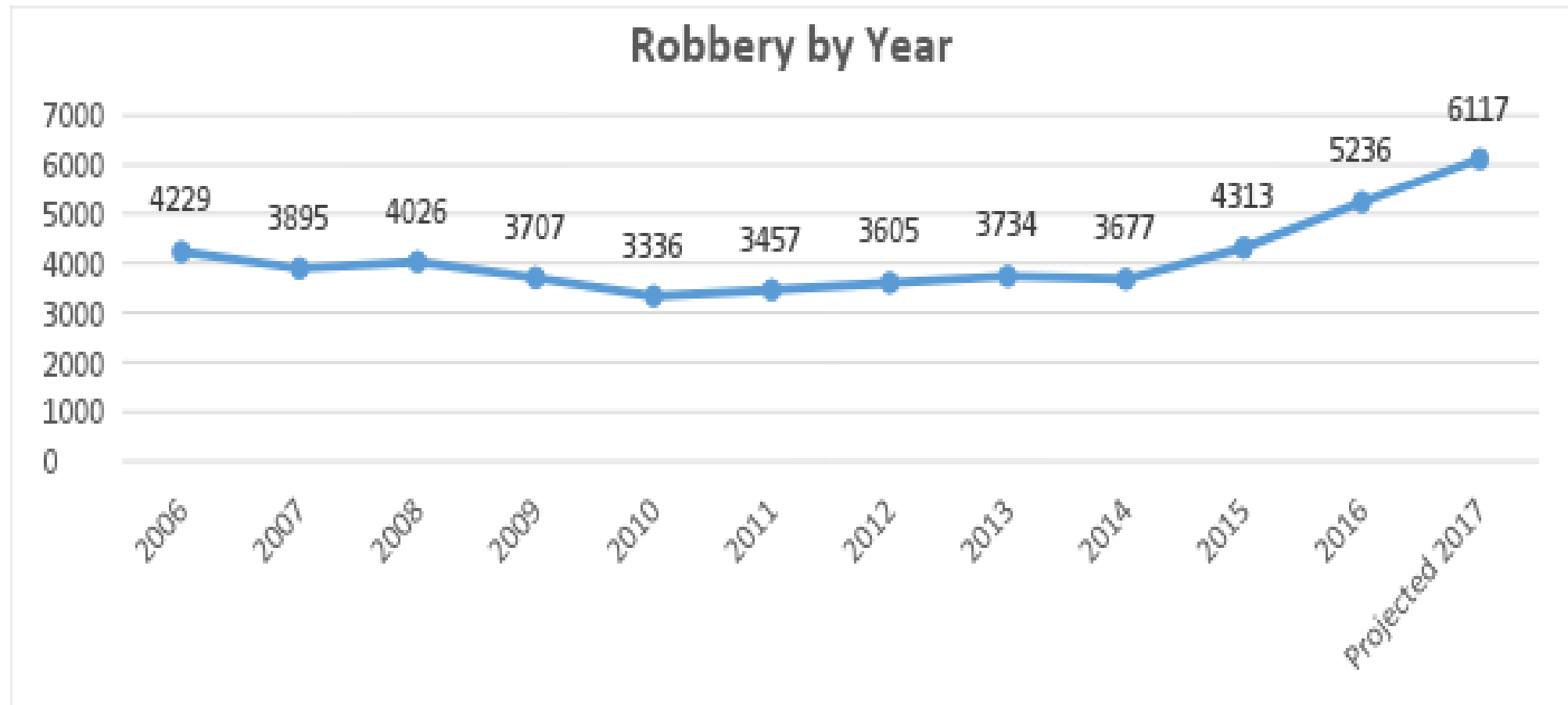

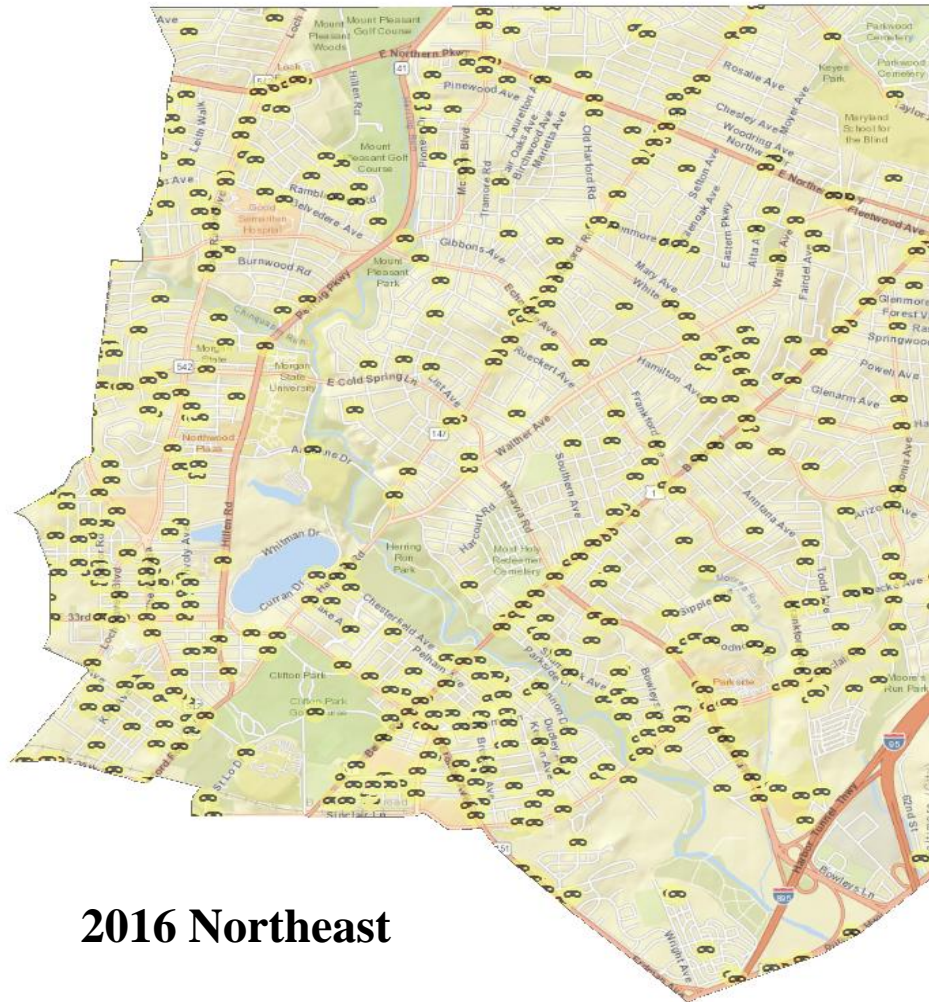

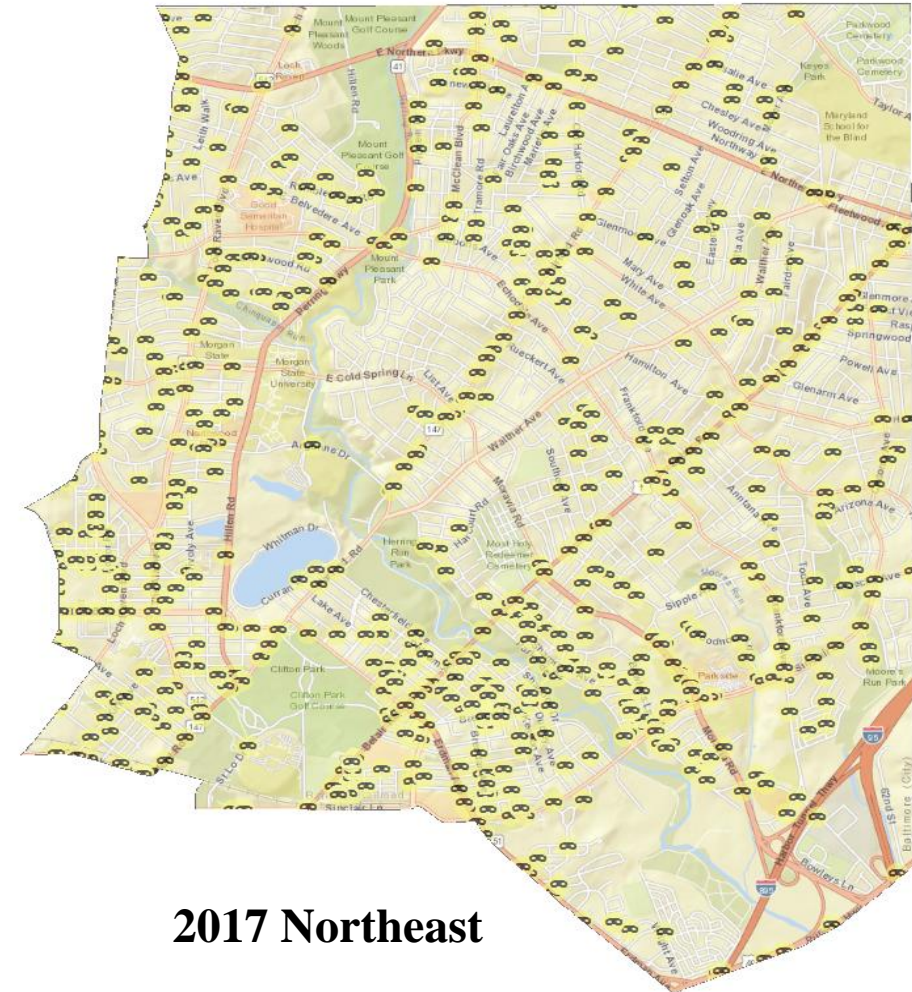

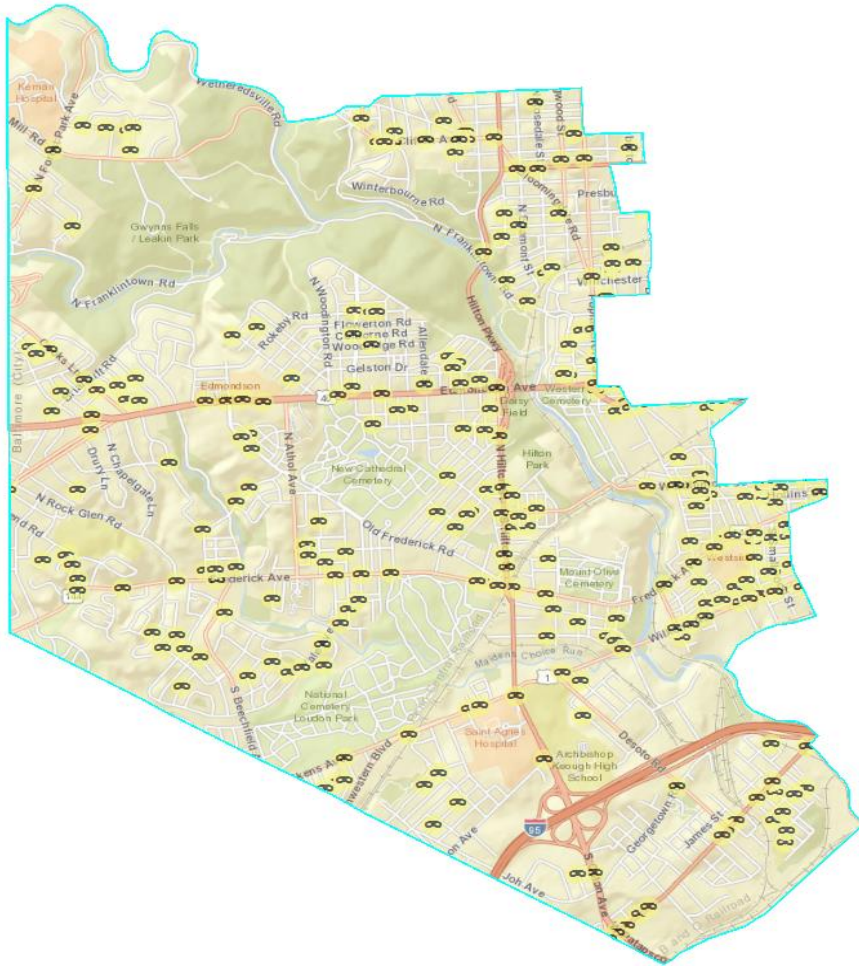

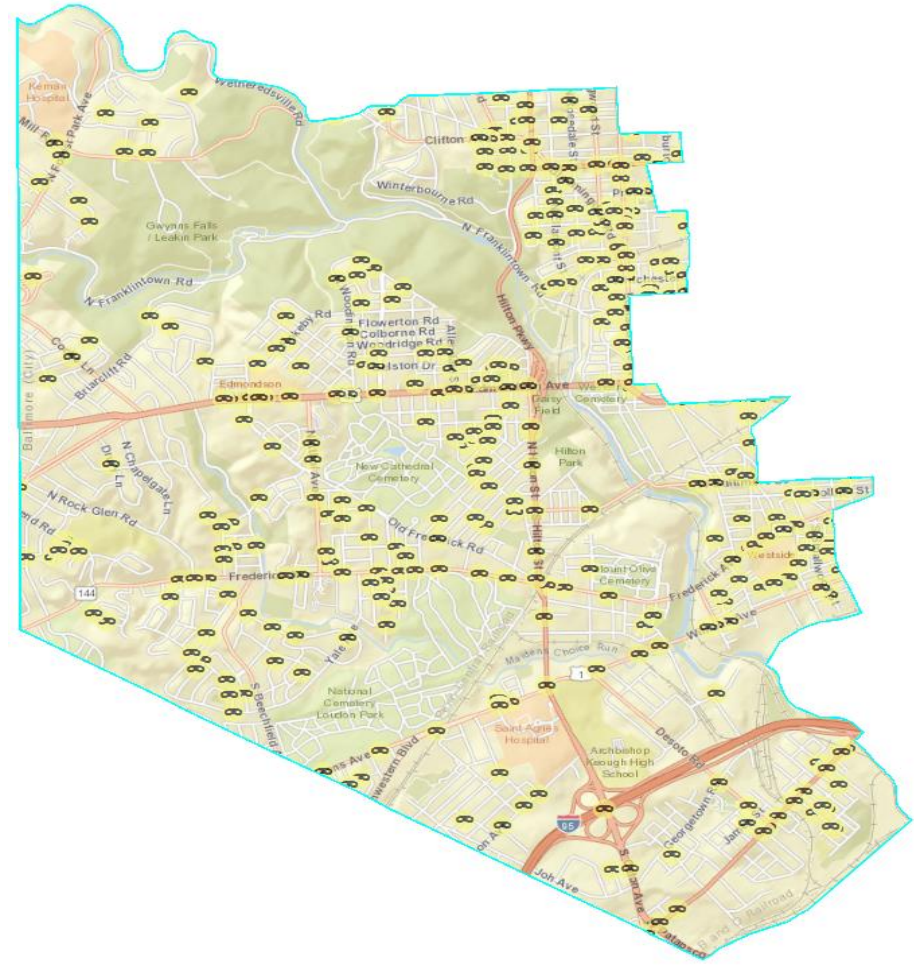

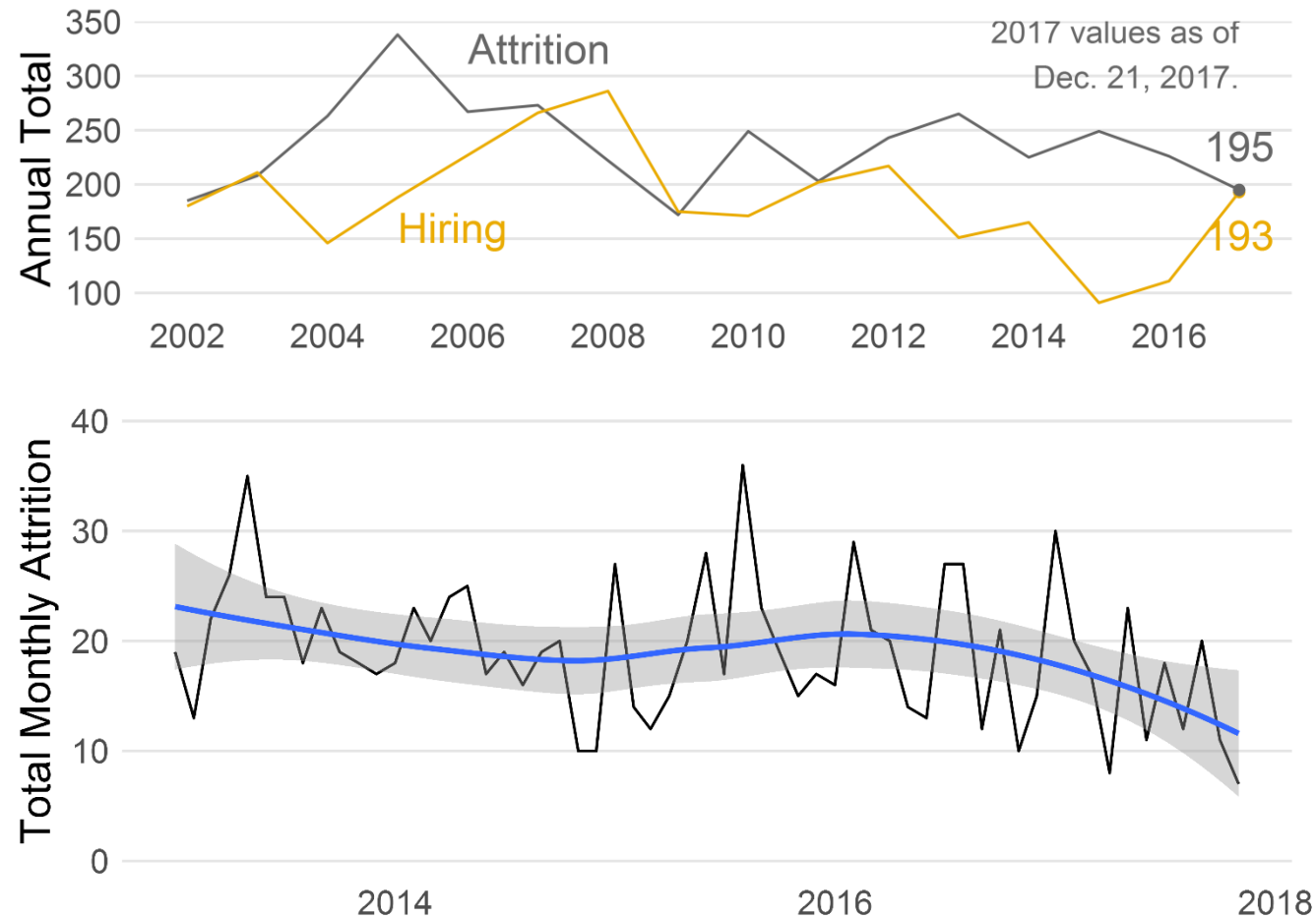
