

Making Progress

• **RecPro Dashboard.** The following chart shows the total number of visitor scans for each recreation facility for the months of October, November, and December. The specific sites that were highlighted at the last CitiStat for poor performance have rebounded. Those sites are Bentalou, Coldstream, and John Eager Howard. Most other sites either remain consistent with attendance or have improved over the three month span. As more sites are implemented with RecPro, more accurate attendance numbers will be reflected, as seen below.





• Unique Visitors. The following chart shows summarized RecPro data for all recreation facilities. A unique visitor refers to the number of unique individuals who visited one or more recreation facility at least once for the month. This metric is intended to help capture the total number of residents who use recreation facilities. Since July, there has been a steady increase in unique visitors to Recreation Faculties, indicating better reporting techniques.



Snow Prep

• **DOT Snow Prep.** Ahead of the winter storm scheduled for this weekend, DOT has been working with agencies across the city to hold dry runs through snow zones to become familiar with the current conditions of the roadways. The purpose of the dry runs is to ensure the safety of city employees during snow weather events. All city agencies, including Recreation and Parks, completed 100% of their dry runs.

Needs Improvement

• **RecPro Implementation Updates.** The Department is in the process of implementing the RecPro recreation management system to better manage recreation centers and special facilities throughout the City. The following table has been used to track the progress of the RecPro implementation project. Currently there are 35 fully operational sites, an increase of 3 sites from last month, with only a net gain of 8 for CY15. Additionally, CitiStat will follow-up in the coming months to ensure the project plan for the remaining 19 sites is completed by the end of the fiscal year.
