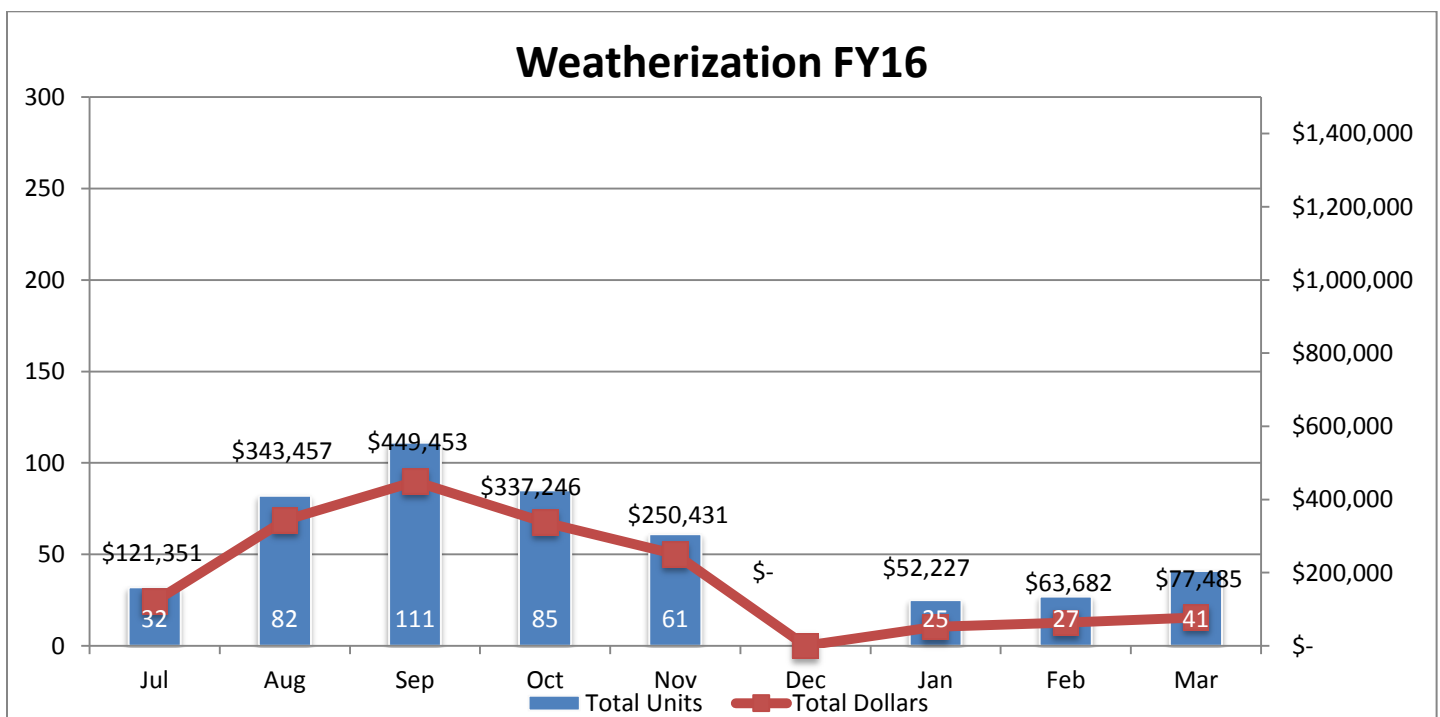

Making Progress

- **New Weatherization Process.** In order to have more checks in the system, and to be able to hold contractors more accountable for the work that is done for weatherization, a new process map has been developed by the agency that increases accountability. The new process has been implemented and will be used going forward. After a slowdown in the winter months, production is improving and is projected to increase to over 70 units served in the next CitiStat reporting period.



Needs Improvement

- **Code Enforcement.** To maintain safe and attractive neighborhoods throughout the city, Baltimore Housing’s Code Enforcement Division enforces the city’s housing, zoning, building and related code. There are 4 Housing Code Enforcement districts, (NW, NE, SE, SW) which are further divided into sub districts.
- The CitiStat template shows a high number of Code Enforcement Reinspections overdue. There have been at least 13,000 reinspections overdue dating back to the start of FY16. The chart below is a snapshot of the overdue inspections since the start of CY16.
