## • Needs Improvement

o **Grass Mowing.** Grass mowing has been a topic of discussion over the past few DOT Stat meetings. As you can see from the graph below the closed on time percentage has decreased substantially to below 50%. One thing worth noting, however, is the amount of requests closed during the September 23<sup>rd</sup> period, approximately 140 which is more than any previous period shown. The reason behind the low closed on time percentage is due to fact that many old requests were finally resolved.
